Time to complete with Eve: 15 minutes
Work distribution (editing): 90% Eve, 10% User

Intake Call, Intake Form, and Email Summarization

Time to complete (before Eve): 3-4 hours
Time to complete with Eve: 15-30 minutes
Work distribution (editing): 80% Eve, 20% User

Time to complete (before Eve): 1-2 hours
Time to complete with Eve: 45 minutes
Work distribution (editing): 90% Eve, 10% User

Drafting Complaint

Time to complete (before Eve): 1-2 hours
Time to complete with Eve: 45 minutes
Work distribution (editing): 75% Eve, 25% User

Mediation Statement

Time to complete (before Eve): 4-5 hours
Time to complete with Eve: 1.5 hours
Work distribution (editing): 75% Eve, 25% User

Motion Response

Time to complete with Eve: 10-15 hours
Work distribution (editing): 50% Eve, 50% User
